In the midst of some of these issues what a joy it is to share some news with you this Christmas season. I received a heartening email this week from Rev. Lyton Kilowe, the Minister in charge of the Orbus CCAP Prayer House (church plant) at the Orbus school, with the photos above. Rev. Lyton reports that on the 24th November 2019 twenty people, including some of the Orbus students, were baptised at Orbus during the Sunday service, which is held in one of the classrooms. I know that many of you faithfully pray for the children at Orbus to put their trust in Jesus, so this will no doubt come as very encouraging news for you. Our hearts rejoice in Christ and we marvel at His soul saving, life changing work.
