News Update- September 2015:

Orbus Kindergarten and Primary School, Ngumbe, Malawi: The final day for the 2014/15 school year, the 24th July, was marked by each grade presenting a concert or play, including the kindy class. The headmaster, Mr Wills Mbewe and all the teachers are to be commended for their diligence, very high standard of teaching and the good discipline of the pupils throughout the 2014/15 school year.







The 2015/16 school year started on the 7th September. With the classroom building completed on time, desks made, and a new teacher employed, the new Grade 6 class started well, as did the kindy and grades 1-5. There are about 350 children enrolled from kindy to grade six.

The new Grade 6 class started on the 7th Sept. 2015.

The new two-classroom school building, with office, storeroom and toilets was officially opened on 4th September 2015 by the Blantyre District Commissioner for the Malawi Government Education Department, who as guest of honour, cut the ribbon and opened the doors to the classrooms. The ceremony was opened in prayer and the new school building dedicated to the glory of God and for the benefit of orphans and vulnerable children (OVC) and the Ngumbe community.







Introductions were given by Moses Kasitomu, the Education Secretary for the CCAP Blantyre Synod and speeches were given by John Steendam as representative of Orbus Australia and Synod General Secretary Rev. Alex Maulana, who expressed thankfulness to the partnership with Orbus Australia and their commitment to the Orbus School, and also the partnership with the Presbyterian Church of Australia.

"Teach the children at Orbus God's enduring truths in the Bible, the urgency of trusting Jesus as Saviour and Lord, the value of fearing God, the wisdom in seeking first God's Kingdom, and avoiding the emptiness of worldly falsehoods. Trust God and His perfect ways, not fallen man and his fallen ways."

Orbus High School for OVC in 2016?

We are now encouraged to pray and plan as we look forward to the next stage of the project: starting a secondary school. As mentioned in the June newsletter, many children stop going to school in Malawi at the end of primary school, as secondary education is costly. Many of the OVC who graduate from primary school will be unable to afford to pay full (or any) private secondary school fees, so local donors, other international donors, and/or Orbus Australia will need to be prepared to fill the gaps on an ongoing basis.

Offering secondary education is a big step for us, but this is where we will be able to make a continuing and significant further contribution to this community, as there seems to be a great need for secondary education in Ngumbe generally, and specifically for the orphans and poorer children who will otherwise not go to high school at all.

Orbus could simply stop where we are and continue to operate just a kindy and primary school, or we could take this big step and start a secondary school in 2016. Funds will be needed to build more classrooms and employ more teachers and staff (until fees are adequate). So, prayer is requested and if anyone has any interest in becoming involved in starting the Orbus Christian High School please contact me at craig.manners@orbusministries.org.

We will be guided by the response we receive and hope to make a decision in the first quarter of calendar 2016, as work will need to start on a new classroom by around April 2016, along with some teacher's accommodation.
