Orbus Mission Schools Malawi:

A great finish to the 2022/23 school year, and a great start to the 2023/24 school year:

"Senior Secondary School results have been released. Out of the 68 students who sat for the exams at Orbus, 62 passed. This represents a 91% pass rate for Orbus, compared to the national pass rate for the whole of Malawi of 52%." Edmond Kananji (Head Teacher, Orbus Mission Secondary School)

The new school year started well in September 2023:

221 Boarders

88 Orphans and Vulnerable Children (Receiving a free education)

56 Teachers and Staff: Made up as follows:

3 Nursery school teachers.
12 Primary school teachers.
19 Secondary teachers.
22 Secondary school support staff.
